Purpose:

The Outreach Committee conducts a variety of educational and awareness outreach activities to make our organization's presence known to both the general and medical communities around us. In addition, it works to connect TANGO2 families from around the world by providing access to information and firsthand experiences with TANGO2 Disease from parents and professionals.

Committee Composition:

At least 6-10 volunteers who have an interest in TANGO2 outreach.

Committee Roles and Responsibilities:

- Develop an annual calendar for the committee's activities, including critical dates, milestones and required actions
- Engage in advocacy and networking
- Work to develop a Community Outreach "Toolkit" (e.g., T2T task list: scripts, wordly, Canva documents for T2T and links to Facebook)
- Work to promote, engage and participate in TANGO2 events and activities
- Track and report progress toward goals to the Board

Committee Members Expectations:

- Attend and participate in regular Committee meetings and if not able to attend RSVP to Outreach Committee chairperson
- Review materials, provide input and execute on committee initiatives and campaigns
- Serve as an internal/external link for the TANGO2 Research Foundation to open doors to further the organization's mission and vision.
- Participate in implementation of the committee goals.

Time Commitment:

- 2-4 hours a month (including meetings and events)
- Attend monthly committee meetings (at least 80% of meetings throughout the year)
