On November 13-14, the Milken Institute Health Summit in Washington DC brought together over 1,200 healthcare leaders. TANGO2 Research Foundation's Director of Research Engagement Deena Chisholm shared insights on designing patient-centered research, emphasizing meaningful engagement with underrepresented communities like those in the rare disease space. She highlighted strategies to foster trust, address participation barriers, and build lasting partnerships for equitable health solutions.
