## WHAT IS TANGO2 DEFICIENCY DISORDER?

TANGO2 Deficiency Disorder is a rare genetic condition that can affect multiple systems in the body, especially the heart, muscles, and brain. Individuals with TDD are at risk for life-threatening metabolic crises, arrhythmias, developmental delays, and muscle weakness.

Because TDD is newly discovered (2016), research is ongoing — and many families remain undiagnosed. **Our mission is to lead the way in finding a cure for TANGO2 deficiency disorder.**
